iii. Non adherence to safety rules, and regulations.

iv . Poor Response to Monitored Networks.

V. Inadequate knowledge and Ignorance on the part of operators/consumers/public.

vi. Poor Terminations
& poor maintenance
of Ageing Networks

vii. Vandalism
