Electrocutions in September 2017 still high at 5 fatalities

- Networks rectified by Discos to be verified by NEMSA
 engineers/technical officers either weekly or forth-nightly
 not at month-end only when the reports fall due.
- Discos' efforts on disconnection / removal of structures/buildings/premises under power supply lines to be intensified.
- Discos' efforts at sensitization of the Public on using electricity safely and wisely to be intensified.

Many of the accidents that occur in the power sector can be attributed to seven (7) major factors:

(a) System
Protection
Equipment
Failures;

(d) Poor Response to Monitored Networks & use of substandard materials.

(g) Vandalism

(b) In some cases, total absence of protection devices. (e) Non adherence to safety rules, and regulations.

(c) Poor Terminations, poor maintenance of Ageing Networks, Right-of-way issues.

(f) Inadequate knowledge and Ignorance on the part of operators/consumers/public.

Operators of the Power Sector to address these points urgently.

Notification by Discos to NEMSA for verification should be weekly, rather than waiting till end of the month.





Discos to intensify efforts at rectifying their defective networks to prevent electrical accidents.



SAFETY TIPS FOR THE RAINY SEASON:

- Avoid contact with electric poles, tv antenna poles, conductors and other electrical equipment installed in the open, during rainfall
- Avoid staying under trees and tall objects during thunderstorms
- Avoid climbing masts during rainfall/thunderstorms
- Avoid power cables and metallic objects during rainfall
- Wear rubber sole shoes always when on wet grounds
- Report any fallen electric poles or conductors to the nearest electricity utility company or to NEMSA office nearest to you.
